

MAHASKA COUNTY 2024 DUST CONTROL POLICY

It is time for dust control planning!

The following dates are tentative and subject to change...

Applications and permits received by April 12th will be available for treatment on or after May 18th. If you miss the April 12th deadline, you WILL NOT be able to get your area treated until June 3rd. Second applications will be applied on or after July 22, 2024.

Contractor flags and dust control signs are available at the Mahaska County Engineer office located at 2074 Old Highway 163, Oskaloosa, or from the contractor.

***If you are using H&D Services**, office 641-623-2330 cell 641-990-2161 product is Lignin Sulfonate (tree sap) & Mag Chloride combination Please fill out the dust control permit enclosed and submit the \$25.00 fee to Mahaska County Engineer,
2074 Old Hwy. 163, Oskaloosa, IA 52577.

Once received, the Engineer will forward a copy of the permit to H&D. The customer is responsible for contacting H&D regarding their service and fees, and for clearly marking the area that dust control will be applied. Mahaska County will prepare the road as needed.

Product: Lignin Sulfonate (tree sap) & Mag Chloride combination

***If you are using Binns & Stevens**, office 641-672-2566, product is Calcium Chloride. Please refer to their website or contact them at the number above, regarding all forms and fees, including Mahaska County's permit fee. Once paid, notification will be sent to Mahaska County Engineer. It is the customer's responsibility to clearly mark the area that dust control will be applied. Mahaska County will prepare the road as needed.

MAHASKA COUNTY GUIDELINES

1. Petroleum products and used oil are not allowed.
2. Width of application must be at least 20 feet wide.
3. Permit applicant is responsible for placing and maintaining flags as well as "DUST CONTROL" signs at each end of the treated surface. County is not responsible for broken or damaged signs.
4. The County reserves the right to blade the road at any time and is not responsible for lost dust control.
5. The permit is valid until October 1, 2024. After that date, Mahaska County will blade or rock the road as needed for winter preparation.
6. Mahaska County has no obligation and will assume no responsibility for the dust control product or application. Complaints regarding the performance of the dust control product should be directed to the applicator.
