

MAHASKA COUNTY 2023 DUST CONTROL POLICY

It is again time for dust control planning!

The following dates are tentative and subject to change... All applications received by April 17th will be available for treatment by the applicator that you choose on or after May 20th.

If you miss the April 17th deadline, you WILL NOT be able to get your road treated until June 1st.

Second applications will not be applied until July 22, 2023.

***If you are using H&D Services as your applicator**, or doing the dust control yourself, please fill out the dust permit enclosed and submit the fee of \$25.00 to:

Once received, Secondary Roads will forward a copy of the permit application to H&D. You are then responsible for making payment to them for services and marking each end of the dust control length.

***If you are using Binns & Stevens**, contact them regarding all necessary paperwork. Payment of fees and services will be paid directly to them for the permit and product application. They will notify Mahaska County of your application & payment.

Flags for marking, as well as dust control signs, are available at the Mahaska County Secondary Roads Department office OR from the applicator you choose.

GUIDELINES

1. Petroleum products and used oil are not allowed.
2. Width of application must be at least 20 feet wide.
3. Permit applicant is responsible for placing and maintaining flags as well as "DUST CONTROL" signs at each end of the treated surface. County is not responsible for broken or damaged signs.
4. The County reserves the right to blade the road at any time and is not responsible for lost dust control.
5. The permit is valid until October 1, 2023, after that date, Mahaska County will blade or rock the road as needed for winter preparation.
6. Mahaska County has no obligation and will assume no responsibility for the dust control product or application. Complaints regarding the performance of the dust control product should be directed to the applicator.
