It was moved by Groenendyk seconded by Cox to approve the agenda with the deletion of the approval of the minutes for May 15,30 and 31. All ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Cox seconded by Groenendyk to approve the bills for May in the amount of \$1,002,891.35 and payroll in the amount of \$311,346.48. All ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Groenendyk seconded by Cox to approve the recommendation of Joleen Nelson, CPC to approve the contract agreement for the provision of Mental Health Services between Mahaska County, Iowa and South Central Mental Health Center, Inc. for fiscal year 2000-2001. All ayes. Motion carried.

Bids for the maintenance for the Sheriff's cars were opened. Bids were received from Don's Amoco and Carriker Ford. The sheriff recommended the bid from Don's Amoco. It was moved by Groenendyk seconded by Cox to approve the request of the sheriff to award the bid to Don's Amoco for fiscal year 2000-2001. All ayes. Motion carried.

Bids were opened for the purchase of a Motorgrader: Ziegler Inc. Caterpillar Model 140H \$159,968.00 Rexco Equipment, Inc. New Holland Model AG170 \$152,775.00 Swaney Equipment Co. John Deere Model 770 CH \$154,887.00 Road Machinery and Supply Co. Komatsu Model GD650A-2C \$148,196.00

It was decided to get more information about the contract for Technical Assistance from Area 15.

It was moved by Cox seconded by Groenendyk to open the public hearing for the reclassification of Service Area B road to a C class. All ayes. Motion carried. There were no written or oral objections. It was moved by Cox seconded by Groenendyk to close the public hearing. All ayes. Motion carried. It was moved by Cox seconded by Groenendyk to approve the recommendation of the Engineer to approve the following resolution. All ayes. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION Area Service "C" Roads

WHEREAS: Mahaska County desires to classify certain roads on the area service System in the County to provide for a minimal level of maintenance and Access by means of a gate or barrier; and

WHEREAS: the County, after consultation with the County Engineer, has the authority to specify certain roads within the County as Area Service "C" roads pursuant to Iowa Code Section 309.57 (1995) as amended by House File

419 (1996); and

WHEREAS: the County has received a petition, attached to this resolution, signed by all landowners adjoining the road, requesting that the following road be classified as an Area Service "C" road:

Beginning at a point approximately 800 feet east of the south ½ corner of 17-75-14 thence easterly along the centerline of 250th Street approximately 2,000 feet to its termination near the southeast corner of the said section.

- 1. Blading: Blading or dragging will not be performed on a regular basis.
- 2. Snow and Ice Removal: Snow and ice removal will not be performed on a regular basis. Sanding and salting will not be performed on a regular basis.
- 3. Bridges: Bridges on Area Service "C" roads may not be maintained to carry legal loads but will be posted as appropriate to advise of any load limitations.
- 4. Weeds, Brush, and Trees: Mowing or spraying weeds, cutting brush and tree removal will not be performed on a regular basis. Adequate sight distances will not be maintained on a regular road.
- 5. Structures: Bridges and culverts may not be maintained on a regular basis to carry legal loads. Upon failure or loss, the replacement structure will be for traffic thereon.
- 6. Road Surfacing: There will be no surfacing materials applied to Area Service "C" roads.
- 7. Shoulders: Shoulders will not be maintained.
- 8. Crown: A crown will not be maintained.
- 9. Repairs: There will be no road repairs on a regular basis.
- 10. Uniform Width: Uniform width for the traveled portion of the road will not be maintained.
- 11. Inspections: Regular inspections will not be conducted.
- 12. Gate: The gate shall be purchased and installed by the County and maintained by the adjoining landowners. If not so maintained, the County may remove the gate; and

WHEREAS, the only persons who will have access rights to the road shall be:

a. the owner, lessee, or person in lawful possession of any adjoining land,

- b. the agent or employee of the owner, lessee or person in lawful possession of any adjoining land,
- c. any peace officer,
- d. any magistrate,
- e. any public employee whose duty it is to supervise the use or perform maintenance of the road,
- f. any agent or employee of any utility located upon the road.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MAHASKA COUNTY that this County does hereby establish the road described as an Area Service "C" road, with restricted access and a minimal level of maintenance.

Motion carried. Time was 11:30 a.m. 11:59 a.m. It was moved by Cox seconded by Groenendyk to return to regular session. All ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Groenendyk seconded by Cox that we are rejecting the offer of settlement in this legal matter. All ayes. Motion carried.
