## November 13, 2012

The Mahaska County Board of Supervisors met in special session at 10:00 a.m. in the third floor conference room of the Mahaska County courthouse. Present were the following board members: Chairman – Greg Gordy; vice chairman – Ken Rozenboom; and member – Henry W.VanWeelden. Also present was Ken Allsup, Osky News; Sue Brown, Deputy Auditor and Kay Swanson, Mahaska County Auditor.

This meeting was filmed by Communication Research Institute of William Penn University.

Chairman Gordy called the meeting to order with a moment of silence.

It was moved by Rozenboom seconded by VanWeelden to approve the agenda. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

County Auditor and Commissioner of Elections, Kay Swanson, reported that the total number of registered voters was 15,845 for the November 6<sup>th</sup> General Election. There were 10,951 who voted. Voter turnout was 69.11%.

After reading the votes cast for each office, it was moved by Rozenboom seconded by VanWeelden to approve the canvass of the votes and declare candidates receiving the most votes to be winners at the General Election held on November 6, 2012. All present voted aye. Motion carried.
