Consideration was given to a 28E agreement between Mahaska County and Keokuk County to share an assistant county attorney. Mr. Blomgren shared that the opportunity came up when a shared assistant between Keokuk and Washington Co was elected as Co Attorney in Jefferson County making this a timely transition. He outlined the increased case load in the last few years and the fact that the county could make better use of trial dates. The split would be 25% Keokuk County/75% Mahaska County.

It was moved by VanWeelden seconded by Wanders to approve and authorize signature on presented 28E agreement for a shared assistant county attorney with Keokuk County. All present voted aye. Motion carried.
