NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the proceedings for vacating said above described portions of county secondary highways be and the same are hereby instituted under and pursuant to provisions of Sections 306.10 – 306.17 inclusive of the 2022 Code of Iowa, said hearing on the proposed vacating of portions of said highways shall be held in the Conference Room in the Mahaska County Courthouse in the City of Oskaloosa, Iowa, at 9:00 a.m., Central Time, on the 21st of March, 2022. Any persons interested therein may appear to object and be heard, and that after said hearing said Board of Supervisors shall enter an order, either dismissing the proceedings or vacating and closing said portions of said highways, or any parts thereof, by resolution in which event it may convey the property to all interested adjoining proprietors in an equitable manner. Each highway or portion thereof shall be considered separately and a decision to allow or disallow shall in no way affect other highways or portions thereof described in this resolution.

RESOLUTION #2022-09

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO BE SUBMITTED FOR A USDA RURAL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT GRANT FOR FUNDING IMPROVEMENTS TO 275th STREET IN MAHASKA COUNTY, IOWA.

WHEREAS: The proposed improvements to 275th Street is important for rural business development in Mahaska County, Iowa: and

WHEREAS: 275th Street is dedicated to public use and shall remain dedicated to public use following the completion of the project; and

WHEREAS: Old Castle Materials and associated sawmills, transportation companies, suppliers and other businesses are a critical piece of the overall economic picture including rural business development grant of Mahaska County; and

WHEREAS: The total project cost is estimated to be \$750,000; and

WHEREAS: Funding assistance from the USDA Rural Business Development Grant is essential to the success of the project and without the funding the project would not be possible, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Mahaska County, Iowa as follows:

Section 1: Mahaska County fully endorses and supports the USDA Rural Business Development Grant application be submitted to the USDA for improvements to 275th Street.

Section 2: Mahaska County agrees to maintain jurisdiction over the improved road and to provide regular maintenance to ensure the longevity of the project following completion of improvements.

Section 3: Mahaska County and its partners agree to contribute matching funds of \$610,000 toward the project.

Section 4: The Chair of the Board of Supervisors for Mahaska County and the County Auditor are directed to sign and execute the grant application and any related documents needed for the application.

PASSED AND APPROVED this 22nd day of February, 2022.

It was moved by Wanders seconded by Webb to approve agreement with City of Oskaloosa for inclusion of annexed area in Spring Creek township into Precinct 8. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Wanders seconded by Webb to designate board chair as contact for permission for CR3 Connect to enter county owned land for surveying purposes in reference to the Navigator Heartland Greenway pipeline project. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Webb to increase County Annex Building and Mahaska Building values for insurance purposes by \$150,000 and \$100,000 respectively. Motion died for lack of second. This agenda item will be tabled to next regular meeting.

Discussion held on need for contract with 911 for purchase of radios in new emergency communications system. Jamey Robinson noted that number of radios needs to be clarified and that numbers affect discounts. Secondary Road had cut back from their original number. The towers are up and it is expected that the system would be turned over to Racom on April 4, 2022.
